Paul exhorts us to do everything in the name of Jesus giving thanks to God. That's a tall task! That requires thinking about everything we do as an opportunity to glorify God and His Son Jesus. To do things "in Jesus' name' is the same thing as glorifying Him and God. 'Glory' means heavy, weighty. To glorify means to make God weighty, heavy; to make people know how magnificent and glorious He is. How can we do this?
